Our carpet tiles are composed of two key components – yarn and EcoBase backing – that come together just as neatly as they can later be taken apart. As part of our continuous efforts to reduce our carbon footprint we are proud to launch a new and improved EcoBase backing, which sees a new bio-based ingredient replace a core ingredient formerly composed of petroleum-based content.



OUR CIRCULAR CARBON FOOTPRINT

Together with our holistic design approach and carefully considered materials, our closed-loop system ensures that our carpet tiles record an impressively low circular carbon footprint – one we're continually working, alongside our partners and customers, to shrink even further.
